

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### **Non-Uniform Dress Code**

Cleanliness, personal appearance, and proper dress are important in setting the pattern of school and social conduct. Consequently, good and proper grooming should be conducted at all times. School should be thought of as one's place of business where appropriate self-presentation is essential.

Please abide by the following guidelines unless KPCA states otherwise for a specific event or activity.

- 1. Hats and sunglasses are not permitted.
- 2. Closed toe shoes are required. Clogs, Crocs, sandals, flip-flops, etc. are not permitted.
- 3. No tube tops, see-through blouses, bare backs, bare midriffs, fishnet jerseys, halter-tops, or tank tops are permitted.
- 4. No written messages or pictures or symbols on clothing which portray messages related to drugs, alcohol, smoking, sexual conduct or profanity.
- 5. No clothes with metal studs, ornaments, or other objects that could scratch furniture or cause damage may be worn. Metal cleats or shoe taps are not permitted.
- 6. Mini-skirts and "cutoffs" are not permitted.
- 7. Ripped or torn clothing are not permitted.
- 8. Students should not wear clothing that creates classroom/school disorder or distracts the attention of another student in class from learning.

Students who fail to meet these acceptable standards shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures.
